About The American University in Cairo: Founded in 1919, AUC's campus is currently located in Cairo, Egypt, but will be moving to a new, state-of-the-art campus in New Cairo beginning Fall Semester, 2008. AUC's degree programs are accredited by the Commission on Higher Education of the Middle States Association of Colleges and Schools; Engineering programs are accredited by ABET and the Management program is accredited by AACSB. In view of AUC's protocol agreement with the Egyptian government, which requires specific proportions of Egyptian, U.S., and third country citizen faculty, at this time preference will be given to qualified applicants who are U.S. citizens.

The normal teaching load is three courses per semester and English is the language of instruction. For expatriates, benefits include housing, annual round-trip air travel for appointee and qualifying dependents, plus schooling for the equivalent of up to two children at Cairo American College.

Job Description: The Department of Management invites applications for positions in Finance. The successful applicant will have expertise in one or more of several possible subfields, including investments, corporate finance, financial markets, insurance, banking, **real estate** and financial management.

Requirements: A Ph.D. is required. The applicant should be actively engaged in research to maintain an AACSB accreditation and have a solid understanding of the practical issues faced by managers. Strong potential for outstanding teaching is required. Applicants should demonstrate high potential for a strong record in research and excellent student evaluation in teaching.

Additional Information: Tenure track position. One-, two- or three-year appointment, subject to mutual agreement will begin September 2009. Renewal of an appointment depends upon institutional needs and the appointee's performance.
