Job Descriptions: The successful candidate must demonstrate the knowledge, interest and ability for college level instruction, research and development in the dynamic field of real estate. The successful candidate will serve as the Director of the Arnold and Dianne Gazarian Real Estate Center. The candidate will normally teach 6 units per semester and actively participate in ancillary organizations, boards and/or committees that augment and support the underlying real estate program. Specific assignments will depend on department needs. Other key responsibilities include, but are not limited to, advising students, participating in program development, performing outcomes assessment and service learning, pursuing public and private grants, as well as, engaging in community outreach and committee service at all levels of university governance. The successful candidate may be called upon to teach in a distance-learning mode and encouraged to develop web-enhanced and/or web-based instruction. Outcomes assessment and service learning are important components of the university curriculum. The successful candidate will be expected to communicate effectively and work cooperatively with faculty.

Qualifications:

1. Academic Preparation: An earned doctorate in real estate or related field from an accredited institution or equivalent is required for appointment to a tenure track position. Professional designations in the field of real estate (e.g., CCIM, CPM, MAI) are desirable. For appointment to the rank of Associate Professor or Professor, the candidate must have a strong record of excellence in teaching at the university level and an excellent record of scholarly research and publication.

2. Teaching or Other professional Experience: The successful candidate is expected to demonstrate a commitment to teaching excellence and scholarly activity at the university level, and must have the ability to work effectively with faculty, staff and students from diverse ethnic, cultural, and socioeconomic backgrounds. The candidates should also have practical understanding and or experience in the business realm of real estate (e.g., investment, development, transaction) to complement academic capabilities.
