All finance specialty areas will be considered, although corporate finance, derivatives, institutions, **or real estate** may be preferred. One (possibly two) tenure-track position(s) are available. A doctorate in finance is required. ABD's near completion will also be considered. Evidence of the potential to publish in top finance journals is required. Duties will include teaching at the undergraduate and MBA levels, research, and professional service. Teaching loads, salary, and benefits are competitive. Consistent evidence of excellence in teaching and research will be required for continued reappointment, promotion, and tenure. The Department of Finance is part of the College of Business and Behavioral Science, and currently consists of nine tenured/tenure-track faculty and 1 full-time lecturer. Departmental faculty hold Ph.D.'s from top schools across the nation, and have published numerous articles in top-tier journals while at Clemson. Financial Management is one of the fastest growing majors at Clemson and enjoys an excellent reputation with employers including Bank of America and General Electric. Clemson's undergraduate business programs were ranked 22nd among public universities by *Business Week* in 2008. Following its designation as Public University of the Year in 2001 by *Time Magazine* and *Princeton Review*, the University announced its goal was to become a Top-20 Public University. Since then, Clemson's ranking by *U.S. News and World Report* has improved every year including a jump from 30th in 2006 to 27th in 2007.

Clemson University is a highly selective, public, land-grant university in a college-town setting along the dynamic I-85 corridor in the southeast, and against a beautiful backdrop of lakes and mountains. While enjoying the benefits of a small college town, our faculty enjoy opportunities afforded by a 30 minute commute from Greenville, SC (a thriving mid-sized city with a strong industrial base, home to BMW and Michelin) and about a two-hour drive to either Atlanta, GA or Charlotte, NC.
