All applicants *must* demonstrate proficiency in *any two* of the following areas; banking, insurance, and real estate. Minimum qualifications include an M.B.A. or other Masters degree in a relevant field. Prior professional experience and/or professional certification are preferred characteristics. An established record of effective teaching at the college level is desired.

Initial interviews will be conducted at the 2009 ASSA meetings in San Francisco. Applications will be accepted through March 31, 2008 or until position is filled.
