The School of Business Administration at Portland State University seeks exceptional candidates for a tenure track position at the rank of Assistant or Associate Professor in Real Estate Finance beginning September 16, 2009. We are seeking candidates pursuing research on the financial aspects of sustainability as it pertains to real estate. The candidate should have an earned doctorate in business or related field with an emphasis in real estate finance. The candidate must offer evidence or promise of an innovative program of research as well as demonstrated excellence in teaching. This position will play a vital role in the Center for Real Estate, a collaborative effort between the School of Business and the College of Urban and Public Affairs. Currently the two units offer a graduate certificate in real estate development and an undergraduate degree in real estate finance. A Masters degree in Real Estate has been designed and is going through the approval process. The Center also offers an annual conference that attracts 500-600 real estate professionals. The School of Business serves over 3,600 students including more than 400 graduate students. The School's MBA+ program was ranked 22nd in the world and 15th in the country by *Beyond Grey Pinstripes* for the integration of social and ecological issues into curriculum and the focus on social and ecological issues in faculty research. Portland State University is dispersed over 49 acres of green space amidst the cultural and business center of downtown Portland. Portland is a thriving city of natural beauty located within an hour's drive of mountains, forests, and the Oregon coast.
