4. **Real Estate Finance.**

Publications in highly regarded refereed academic journals are required for promotion and tenure. Salary is dependent on rank and qualifications and is within the range typically available in the California State University System.

Review of applications will begin on September 15 and will continue until the position is filled. Candidates must be academically qualified by current AACSB standards. Candidates must possess a doctoral degree in financial economics from an AACSB accredited institution or equivalent, prior to starting the position in August 2009.

The Department offers two undergraduate degrees (Corporate Finance and Financial Services) and two graduate degrees, MBA & a MSBA in Finance. Courses are offered in the areas of Corporate Finance, Data Analysis, Financial Institutions and Markets, International Finance, Investments, Real Estate, Risk Management, and Venture Financing. The Department currently has approximately 9 full-time tenure/tenure-track faculty and numerous part-time faculty.

The College of Business is AACSB accredited at both the graduate and undergraduate levels and serves approximately 650 graduate and 4,500 undergraduate students, seeking an EMBA, MBA, MSBA, or BA degree. Courses are offered day and evening. The College has approximately 100 full-time tenured / tenure-track faculty. The EMBA, MBA, and MSBA programs are housed in a new state of the art educational facility, located in the heart of San Francisco's downtown financial and shopping center. The undergraduate business program is located in the university's main campus.
